### **Green and connected across the four seasons**

We envisage that Mustamäe in 2030 we be an inclusive, engaged and sustainable community by bringing diverse groups together through seasonally-designed activities. We will achieve this through both a short-term and longer-term vision:

- *Mustamäe Today: Community across four seasons*
- *Mustamäe 2030: Green and connected*

The short-term vision, *Community across four seasons*, involves using the courtyards and garages as spaces for seasonally-related, knowledge-exchange workshops and thematic activities culminating in a festival for each season. This will help to build community engagement, a care and share economy and a greater awareness of sustainability.

These values and skills help bring about our longer-term vision, *Green and connected*. This vision is about creating green connections across larger scales. Firstly, creating a green corridor to foster green activity spaces and preserve biodiversity. This will increase human wellbeing through providing recreational spaces, sounds barriers and improving human-nature connections. Secondly, we reconnect the city in greener ways through shared mobility services including bikes, e-scooters and cars.

We expect both the construction of this green corridor and the mindshift toward sustainable transport will be possible through the fostering community engagement, a caring, sharing economy and sustainability awareness in the short-term vision.
