The University campus will be part of a new, modern area that drives progress for the City of Riga. Our integrated approach focuses on fostering a symbiotic relationship between students, locals, businesses on Monk island, and ecosystems in the area, while revitalizing Tornakalns district. This will set the stage for modernizing the left bank of the Daugava River and the rest of Riga.

The main pillars of our plan include physical, social, and time-related considerations throughout the development of the new campus. We plan to connect the district by public transportation and bicycle friendly roads to enable access in an eco-friendly way. A bike hub will encourage people to ditch their private cars and commute more sustainably. Public spaces, multifunctional art installations, and a student bar will bring the campus to life.
