Features of the networked system will enable connections with the past, the varied cultural and biological heritage, and other groups and individuals by offering a clean, safe, high-quality environment, stable ecosystem and innovative economy.

Implementing multi-function buildings and catering places that provide outside hubs for students, locals, and entrepreneurs may favour knowledge transfer and sharing. The water stream renewal, green puff retention, multi-functional tunnel constructions, public spaces for art and culture displays will offer means to diffuse renewal activity into surrounding areas.
